FLOOD REPORT



Flood Situation as on Today i.e. 31st July, 2016

Overall Situation: Nearly 16,63,841 people are affected by floods in 21 districts of Assam. The most affected districts are Golaghat, Barpeta, Goalpara, Dhubri, Darrang & Morigaon, where over one lakh people are affected in each district. Authorities have opened 310 Relief Camps & 153 Relief Distribution Centre that houses total 1,47,167 inmates. Relief has been distributed as per requirement in all the flood affected districts. NDRF and SDRF are helping the district administration in evacuating the affected population to safe places.
