The bund badly damaged on 09-07-19 by the river Jiabharali at down stream of chamdhara which was constructed by other agency. <p>Sonitpur:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Soil erosion is taking place at Khagarijan L.P School of Belsiri river under Thelamara R.C. <p>Udalguri:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Severe erosion occurred at village Kukurbhuka by river Monai, Buari by river Rowta and Adarsha by river Ojagar under Mazbat R.C. <p>Baksa:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Beki river embankment in erosion at village Khagrabari (800 M), erosion at village Gobardhana (1200 M), erosion at village Chunbari (1 KM) and erosion at village Bahbari Narayanguri Zero Point (1 KM) under Jalah R.C. - ❖ **Dhemaji:** Only 687 Hect. Crop area affected and 1,588 (Big) & 1,112 (Small) animals are affected in 32 villages under Dhemaji R.C. as reported by DDMA, Dhemaji
- ❖ **Darrang:** Only paddy fields are submerged in 18 villages under Dalgaon R.C. as reported by DDMA, Darrang.
- ❖ **Barpeta:** Only 73 Hect. Crop area affected in 15 villages under Chenga R.C. and only 64 hect. Crop area affected in 2 villages under Sarthebari R.C. as reported by DDMA, Barpeta.
- ❖ **Morigaon:** Only 952 Hect Crop area affected in 62 villages under Mayong R.C. as reported by DDMA, Morigaon.
- ❖ **Hojai:** Only 1.7 Hect. Crop area affected in 2 villages under Lanka R.C. as reported by DDMA, Hojai.
- ❖ **Golaghat:** Only 372.82 Hect. Crop area affected in 10 villages under Khumtai R.C. as reported by DDMA, Golaghat.
