In partial modification of this Department's earlier Order No. HLA.301/2020/177 dated 21st April, 2021, the following categories of passengers arriving by flights and trains from outside the State, in connection with the election to the Assam Legislative Assembly, are exempted from undergoing compulsorily home quarantine for seven days on arrival in Assam:-

- 1. Leaders of recognised political parties
- 2. Accredited journalists.

However, the persons falling in the above categories will have to (i) undergo the mandated COVID-19 test on arrival and (ii) remain in isolation till the RT-PCR test result is declared to be negative.
